On July 20 the Middle Tennessee Genealogical Society will meet at 1:00 at the FiftyForward Center, 174 Rains Avenue, Nashville. The program will be "Finding Your Ancestors Thru 19th-Century Photography," presented by Lynda Massey. Mrs. Massey will be speaking about the different types of 19th century photographs, how to identify them, how to date them, and how to care for them.

Mrs. Massey, a native Nashvillian, holds an Associate's Degree in Science and is currently the Living History Coordinator at the Belle Meade Plantation. She is a member of several lineage societies and frequently gives talks and demonstrations for organizations.
