Mocavo.com now has access to the U.S. census records. If you are not familiar with Mocavo, it is a free research site; like many others it does require creating a user account. Unfortunately, a quick search of the census seems to indicate that the images link to the same occasionally very bad images on Ancestry...just as Heritage Quest now does. The census is searchable, however, and it is a free site.
